


## HARRIS LIGHT 20" INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

- Wear Gloves! This will protect the finish on
  your light, so that it will patina evenly over time.
- 2 Unwrap all parts of light, including canopy and down-rod.
- 3 Screw the down-rod into the nozzle that is at the top of the shade.
- Screw the knurled ring so that it moves off
- the hang-straight, downward toward the shade and slide it over the down-rod to the top of the shade.
- 5 With the lip of the canopy facing up, slip it over the hang-straight and onto the downrod. Gently slide it all the way down to rest on the shade, being careful not to scratch the down-rod.
- 6 Thread the black and white wires through the pipe nipple that is attached to the crossbar (packaged separately in a clear bag), and screw the nipple into the hangstraight. A shorter nipple is included if needed.
- Your light should now be ready to hang!
  Using a licensed electrician, install the light into the junction box.
- 8 Slide the canopy up the down-rod to the
  ceiling, followed by the knurled brass ring.
  Screw the ring onto the threading of the
  hang-straight until the canopy is secured
  against the ceiling.

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## HARRIS LIGHT

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- 2 Unwrap all parts of light, including canopy and down-rod.
- 3 Screw the down-rod into the nozzle that is at the top of the shade.
- A Screw the knurled ring so that it moves off the hang-straight, downward toward the shade and slide it over the down-rod to the top of the shade.
- 5 With the lip of the canopy facing up, slip it over the hang-straight and onto the downrod. Gently slide it all the way down to rest on the shade, being careful not to scratch the down-rod.

  Thread the black and white wires through the pipe nipple that is attached to the crossbar (packaged separately in a paper bag), and screw the nipple into the hangstraight. A shorter nipple is included if needed.
- Your light should now be ready to hang!
  Using a licensed electrician, install the light into the junction box.
- δlide the canopy up the down-rod to the ceiling, followed by the knurled brass ring.
  Screw the ring onto the threading of the hang-straight until the canopy is secured against the ceiling.
